

Third Grade entering Fourth Grade Summer Work

Reading

Please read 1 Accelerated Reader book. It should be middle to high 3rd grade level to early 4th grade level. You know the level book you can read. Please choose a book that is not too difficult but also not too easy. You will be taking an Accelerated Reader test on it when you return to school in the Fall.

Also, I am only requiring 1 book to be read but highly recommend your child read as many as possible this summer. They do not all have to be Accelerated Reader books. The more the children read in the summer the better. Cuyahoga County Libraries usually have a great reading incentive program, I recommend participating in.

Please do not have your child read the book Tales of a Fourth Grade Nothing by Judy Blume. I read this with the class during the school year.

Math

Please do 450 minutes of IXL Third Grade Math. That is 10 minutes a night with a week off. I recommend doing it 10 minutes a night but you can complete the minutes any way you like. Please log in for at least one 10 minute session in the following skills and at least 150 minutes of multiplication facts.
