

Dear Algebra Students and Parents,

As the school year is winding down, we are entering our wonderful summer break. Although this is a time to relax, we must not forget the material we have learned throughout the school year. As in past years, students will be required to complete IXL work for Math. Since your student has been selected for Algebra this means that summer work will be *essential*.

This year students must complete 15 hours of work, which is equivalent to 90 minutes a week. Below is a list of 16 skills that are pre-requisite to Algebra. Students are required to master 10 of the 16 skills. I would recommend doing 30 minutes of the *remaining 6 skills* by the end of the summer to be prepared for the rigorous Algebra curriculum at Holy Family.

I do understand that families plan vacations over the break. I ask if your student is not able to complete a week of minutes due to summer schedules, they are to complete those minutes during the week prior or after.
