

Dear 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> Grade Students and Parents,

As the school year is winding down, we are entering our wonderful summer break. Although this is a time to relax, we must not forget the material we have learned throughout the school year. As in past years, students will be required to complete IXL work for Math. This year I am requiring students to master specific skills and complete a specified amount of minutes every week. These skills are customized to each individual student based on his/her performance on MAP tests taken in the 2018-2019 school year. The mastery of these skills will enable each child to meet with success in the 2019-2020 school year. The following minutes will be the *minimum* number of minutes each student must complete.

**Going into 6<sup>th</sup>: 360 minutes (36 minutes/week)**

*IF YOU HAVE NOT GRADUATED FROM XTRA MATH, YOU MUST GRADUATE BEFORE THE 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR BEGINS. (THESE BASIC SKILLS ARE ESSENTIAL TO ACCESSING THE 6<sup>TH</sup> GRADE MATH CURRICULUM)*

**Going into 7<sup>th</sup>: 480 minutes (48 minutes/week)**

I do understand that families plan vacations over the break. I ask if your student is not able to complete a week of minutes due to summer schedules, they are to complete those minutes during the week prior or after.
